

Guide to SYFAB's Funding News

Our Funding News emails will keep you up to date with all the latest information about funders and fundraising. This guide will show you how to sign up to receive them. Or if you've already signed up, skip through to Step 3 to find out how to use Funding News to search for funders.

Step 1: Go to the Funding News website

Start by getting onto the Internet and going to the SYFAB website:



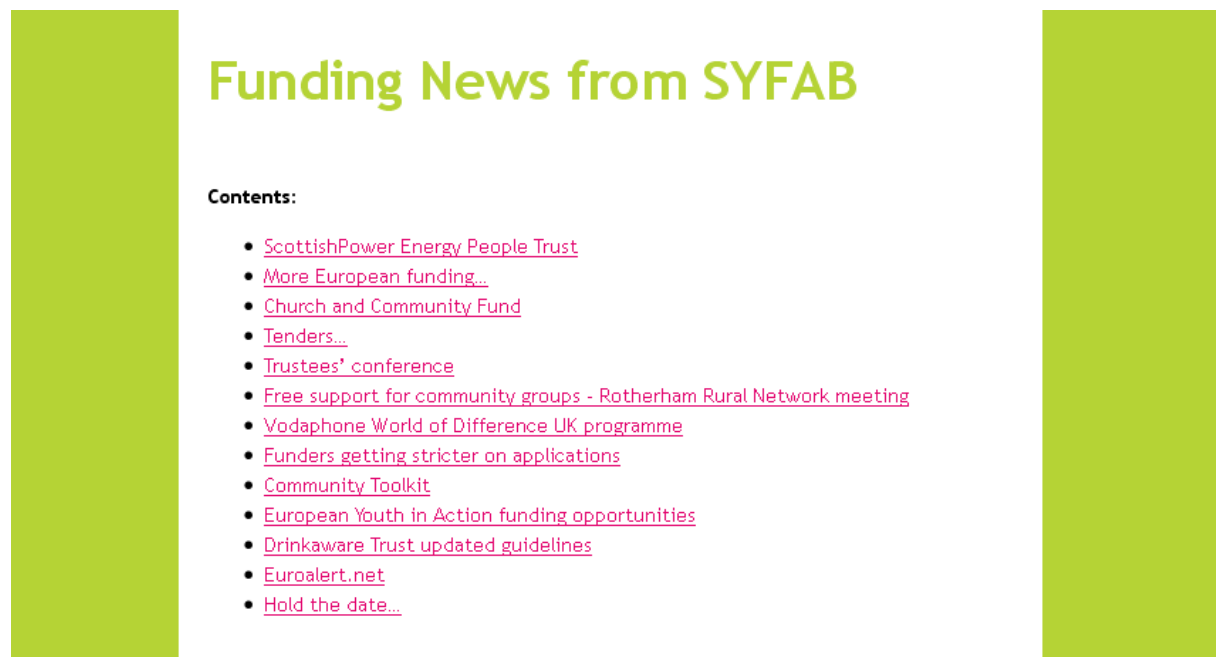

Click 'subscribe' at the bottom. You will then get an email from us. When you click the link in this message to verify your email address, you'll start getting daily or weekly emails with all the new funding news articles added that day or week, it's called 'Posts from Funding News from SYFAB'.

More European funding opportunities

Here's another **European funding opportunity**, this time for **audiovisual festivals**. There is funding for a range of European audiovisual projects through the **MEDIA** programme.

Deadline: 31 October 2011: for projects starting between 1 May 2012 and 31 October 2012

30 April 2012: for projects starting between 1 November 2012 and 30 April 2013

You can use the email link to email the funder

You can use the website link to look at the funder's own website

Common problems:

- Make sure you type your email address in correctly - we see a lot of typos!
- Your email software may treat our Funding News emails as spam. To avoid this, add fundingnews@syfab.org.uk to your address book or contacts list.

Step 3: Using Funding News to search for funders

SYFAB have a free Funding Search database that you can use to find funders for your project. You can sign up to use it here:
